On occasion, I have perused some of the School Board's old minute books and was appalled at their varying stages of disrepair. The minute books date as far back as 1885, and some are tattered and the ink is fading. It would serve this Board's historical perspective to have those records properly stored and catalogued.

I am proposing that a feasibility study be conducted to determine the needs and costs of properly preserving the official records of the School Board.
