Authorization is requested for two students and a teacher to travel to Kigali, Rwanda, to participate in the Africa School Alliance Project, May 26th - June 6th, 2006.

At the Board meeting of August 22, 2001, the School Board approved Item K-2 authorizing the Superintendent to determine the strategy for collaborating with the Foundation for Democracy in Africa (FDA) in an effort to establish a sister-school partnership and student exchange program. As a part of this development, the Foundation for Democracy in Africa is providing funding for two students and a teacher to travel to Kigali, Rwanda, to engage in an education exchange experience with FAWE Girls School.

Last year, the School Board approved the out-of-country field trip to Rwanda for three students and a teacher from Miami Carol City Senior High School to participate in this same exchange program from June 30 – July 10, 2005.
