Authorization is requested for two students and a teacher to travel to Kigali, Rwanda, to participate in the Africa School Alliance Project, May 23<sup>rd</sup> – June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

At the Board meeting of August 22, 2001, the School Board approved Item K-2 authorizing the Superintendent to determine the strategy for collaborating with the Foundation for Democracy in Africa (FDA) in an effort to establish a sister-school partnership and student exchange program. As a part of this development, the Foundation for Democracy in Africa is providing funding for two students and a teacher to travel to Kigali, Rwanda, to engage in an education exchange experience with FAWE Girls School.

Last year, the School Board approved the out-of-country field trip to Rwanda for two students and a teacher from Miami Carol City Senior High School to participate in this same exchange program from May 26<sup>th</sup> – June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2006.
