Pursuant to provisions of the labor contract between Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, Local 1184 (AFSCME), the parties commenced 2017-2018 reopener contract negotiations on August 31, 2017 and reached a Tentative Agreement on December 5, 2017.

The major highlights of the Tentative Agreement are as follows:

- Provides salary adjustments effective July 1, 2017.
- Increases in Health Insurance costs will be absorbed by the District and a free option continues to be available for all employees.

Copies of the Tentative Agreement will be forwarded to Board Members under separate cover and will be placed on file in the Citizen Information Center and the Board Recording Secretary's Office.

This item does not appear on the published Agenda. There exists good cause to vary from the published Agenda as the ratification vote with AFSCME had not been formally confirmed prior to the publication of the Agenda.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, ratify the 2017-2018 Tentative Agreement Addendum to the AFSCME labor contract effective July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018.
