**SUBJECT: COMMISSIONING OF H.A. CONTRACTING CORP. AS CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT-RISK FIRM FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND FUNDED RENOVATIONS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION (P.E.) SHELTER AT HIALEAH MIDDLE SCHOOL, LOCATED AT 6027 EAST 7 AVENUE, HIALEAH, FLORIDA 33013, PROJECT NUMBER 01528800**

Introduction:

In May 2017, a solicitation (Request for Qualifications (RFQ) #155) was published to competitively select Construction Management at-Risk (CMR) firms for the following General Obligation Bond (GOB)-funded projects under the "Procedures for the Selection of Construction Management (CM), CM at-Risk and Program Management Services" (Pilot Program 2<sup>nd</sup> Revision September 6, 2016):

- Renovations at George Washington Carver Middle School (MS)  
4901 Lincoln Drive, Coral Gables, Florida, 33133, Project Number 01423000
- Renovations at Miami Lakes Middle School (MS)  
6425 Miami Lakeway North, Miami Lakes, Florida 33014, Project Number 01529300
- Renovations and New Physical Education (P.E.) Shelter at Hialeah Middle School (MS)  
6027 East 7 Avenue, Hialeah, Florida 33013, Project Number 01528800
- Renovations (Phase I) at Arvida Middle School (MS)  
10900 S.W. 127 Avenue, Miami, Florida 33186, Project Number 01527700

Fifteen (15) firms responded to the solicitation. One (1) firm was not evaluated due to an incomplete RFQ submittal. Fourteen (14) firms were evaluated and eight (8) were shortlisted and invited to interview. However, on October 3, 2017, Thornton Construction Company, Inc., withdrew from the interview process; therefore, the remaining seven (7) firms were interviewed on October 11, 2017, and were subsequently ranked by the Selection Committee, as follows:

This solicitation includes mandatory SBE/MBE sub-consultant and sub-contracting goals, and a Local Workforce Utilization Goal for this project (determined by the M-DCPS Goal Setting Committee), as follows:

Selection:

In accordance with the solicitation and interview process, the highest-ranked firm was selected to negotiate for the highest-valued project (George Washington Carver MS), the second-ranked firm for the second-valued project (Miami Lakes MS), the third-ranked firm for the third-valued project (Hialeah MS) and the fourth-ranked firm for the fourth-value project (Arvida MS).

H.A. Contracting Corp. (HA) was the third-ranked firm and therefore, negotiated for the third-valued GOB funded Renovations and P.E. Shelter project at Hialeah MS. The highest, second and fourth-ranked firms successfully negotiated their respective projects and are being presented under separate Board agenda items. Negotiations with HA were successfully concluded and the firm has agreed to provide the required CMR Programming and Pre-construction Services, as follows:

School Profile:

The existing facility, is on a 22-acre site, comprised of 4 permanent buildings and associated covered walkways, built between 1963 and 1996 with a total of 120,718 GSF.

Preliminary Project Scope:

The GOB funded deficiencies to be addressed for this project consist of campus-wide miscellaneous renovations, including, but not limited to:

- Provide new P.E. Shelter,
- Resurface and restripe parking lots, drives and basketball courts,
- Selective replacement of campus-wide sanitary sewer and domestic water piping,
- Provide mounted building lighting (as required),
- Refinish auditorium seats (as required),
- Replace damaged gas piping,
- Replace chillers and components, reconfigure ductwork/grill and HVAC components (as required), replace obsolete VAV boxes, selective replacement of AHUs, and selective replacement of exhaust fans,
- Selective replacement of restroom fixture,
- Upgrade stage lighting, selective replacement of electrical fixtures,
- Inspect and repair elevator electrical system,
- Upgrade/replace security camera system (as required).
- Selective replacement of flooring, and
- Selective painting (as required).

**Scope of Services:**

The successful CMR entity will be required to provide Pre-construction Services (during all phases of programming and design). The CMR may be required to provide Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) proposal(s) and construction services; or the Board may re-advertise the required services and select another CMR; or select an alternate construction delivery method.

The project must be designed, phased, coordinated and constructed to maximize safety and minimize disruption to the existing, occupied campus.

**Construction Delivery Method:**

To minimize disruption to students and faculty during construction, and in accordance with the M-DCPS Construction Delivery Method Matrix, the CMR delivery method has been selected for this project. However, the Board reserves the right to utilize an alternative delivery method, if deemed to be in the best interest of the Board.

**Office of Economic Opportunity (OEO) Review:**

M-DCPS' OEO staff established the SBE/MBE and M/WBE certification status of the prime firm and each sub-consultant and verified the existence of a Memorandum of Understanding, outlining roles and responsibilities, for each sub-consultant, as follows:

**Construction Budget:** \$2,497,700 (GOB funded)

**Project Schedule:**

HA has agreed to the following A/E's document submittal schedule (and the CMR draft document submittal schedule):

- Preliminary Scope and Estimate Submittal March 16, 2018
- Final Scope Definition Program and Master Plan May 16, 2018

Design milestone dates (contingent on Final Scope Definition Program and Master Plan approval) are as follows:

- Board Commission of A/E (Part 2 services): July 18, 2018
- Phase I - Schematic Design: August 20, 2018
- Phase - II/III Construction Documents 50% complete: October 3, 2018
- Phase - II/III Construction Documents 100% complete: February 13, 2019

Project construction milestone dates are as follows:

- Board Award - Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP): May 2019
- Construction - Substantial Completion by: August 2020

**Terms & Conditions:**

1. HA has agreed to a lump sum fee for CMR Pre-construction Services of \$25,000, which represents approximately 1.00% of the construction budget of \$2,497,700. In consideration for entering into this Agreement, the CMR agrees that any and all costs and fees incurred by the CMR associated with the CMR's performance of all pre-construction services set forth in the Agreement shall be borne solely by the CMR. Pre-construction services fees shall be paid based on completion of the following listed phases/deliverables:

2. The CMR agrees to provide the requisite pre-construction services for this project, including, but not limited to, the following:
  - Review all design and construction documents prepared by the Architect/Engineer of Record (A/E), as well as all existing onsite conditions, to ensure constructability of the project. Review of existing conditions includes cost for all Ground Penetration Radar services;
  - Provide the District with value engineering analysis, cost saving recommendations and estimates throughout the various phases of design;
  - Prepare a master construction schedule to identify potential time saving measures and to facilitate the timely completion of the project;
  - Coordinate with District staff and project A/E to ensure that all necessary testing, permitting applications, and regulatory agency reviews are accomplished;
  - Identify all the various bid packages needed to successfully execute the project, and conduct pre-bid conferences with qualified sub-contractors, material suppliers, and equipment vendors.
  
3. All work shall be in compliance with the State Requirements for Educational Facilities, the Florida Building Code, National Fire Prevention Code, applicable life safety codes, barrier-free design guidelines, Florida Statutes, District Standards and District Policies. Passive design elements and low-energy usage features shall be incorporated in the new work.
  
4. The cost of printing will be reimbursed by the Board on a direct cost basis, per conditions stipulated by the CMR Agreement.
  
5. Upon completion of the pre-construction services, the CMR firm shall negotiate a GMP for the construction project. If accepted, staff will submit the negotiated GMP for Board approval.
  
6. The CMR shall maintain no less than a \$1,000,000 Professional Liability Insurance policy with a maximum deductible of \$50,000, Worker's Compensation/Employers

Liability Insurance, Comprehensive General Liability, and Comprehensive Auto Liability Insurance, all as specified in the Agreement.

7. The Agreement may be terminated by the Board, with cause or for convenience, prior to GMP, upon ten (10) days written notice to the CMR; whereas, the CMR may terminate the Agreement if the work is stopped for a period of 60 days through no act or fault of the CMR.
8. The CMR is required to submit a monthly report to the OEO documenting compliance with the Mandatory SBE/MBE Utilization Goals for sub-consultants and sub-contractors.
9. The CMR has agreed to the terms and conditions of the Agreement and will commence services upon Board commissioning.




