Participation by the Public

DADE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND

Pursuant to Section 237.40, Florida Statutes, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, endorses the formation and incorporation of the Dade Public Education Fund. The School Board will cooperate with the Fund in accordance with the Laws of Florida, State Board of Education rules, School Board rules, and the operating bylaws of the Fund.

The exclusive purpose of the Fund is to operate, receive, hold, invest, and administer property and to make expenditures to or for the benefit of public prekindergarten through 12th grade education in Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, further:

- Authorizes the Chair of the School Board or his/her designee from the School Board and the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee to serve as members of the Fund's governing body, the Board of Directors.
- Authorizes the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee to disburse and account for grant funds allocated to public school recipients.
- 3. Authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to provide office space, supplies, furniture/equipment, and staff support to the Fund.
- 4. Authorizes personnel assigned to provide staff support to the Fund the ability to participate and assist the Fund=s Board in fund-raising activities in furtherance of the Fund's goals and objectives.
