

Administrative Operations

ADMINISTRATIVE CABINET

The Superintendent of Schools is authorized to establish an Administrative Cabinet to provide a communication vehicle by which administrative staff members, under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools, can receive input and approval of materials; i.e., directives, documents, proposed Board Rules, etc., affecting the operation of the schools.

Annually, the Superintendent of Schools shall review the membership of the Administrative Cabinet to make whatever additions or deletions necessary to assure maximum and open communication.

As plans for the various aspects of school operations are made, it is expected that other staff members will be asked to join the group, as may be necessary.

The Superintendent of Schools will establish the schedule of meetings annually.
