UTILITY CONSERVATION

One of the important custodial responsibilities is utility conservation. Each custodian shall report to the principal any faulty equipment or careless use of water, heating, electricity, and gas. The report of an irregularity, such as escaping gas or a damp area in the vicinity of a water main, might occasionally save the school system a great deal of money if reported in the proper manner.
