Permanent Personnel

SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS--QUALIFICATIONS

Each school bus driver shall be of good moral character, possess good vision and hearing, be able-bodied, free from communicable disease, mentally alert, sufficiently strong physically to handle the bus with ease and to make emergency repairs, not a user of alcoholic beverages or narcotics, and possess such other qualifications as shall be prescribed by the State Department of Education.

The school bus driver must hold a school bus driver's license which is current and valid as required by law. The license to drive the school bus must be posted in the bus at all times.

The State Board, upon recommendation of the Commissioner of Education, may revoke any bus driver's license upon sufficient evidence that the holder of the license does not fulfill all qualifications required by law and regulation of the State Board for a school bus driver.
