LEGAL COMMITMENTS--MILITARY PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS

Any regular full-time employee of the school system while engaged in the work of his profession may be excused from duty during school hours when required to report for a pre-induction physical examination or a physical examination required by military orders for entrance into the armed forces of the United States. Such absence from duty will be without loss of pay.
