RECOGNITION--SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS SERVING IN ARMED FORCES

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, through this policy, expresses its desire that former senior high school students who are serving on overseas duty in the armed forces of the United States shall be given proper honor and recognition by the school.

The staff and students of each senior high school shall plan appropriate activities to implement this policy. Some suggested ways are through recognition at assembly programs, articles in school newspapers, name plaques, and the like.

Graduates or Alumni Killed in Service of the United States

When a graduate or an alumnus/alumna of a senior high school is killed in action in the service of the country, the school shall fly the American flag at half staff for a period of one week.
