The Board encourages the administration to search for and experiment with promising organizational plans with the intent of improving the current basic K-5, 6-8, 9-12 organization.

The goals of organization are as follows:

1. Make provision for continuous, flexible, general education for each student.
2. Allow overlapping curriculums at the various age levels to provide for individual differences.
3. Allow criteria other than achievement alone to determine the placement of a given student.
4. Allow extension of the program to younger children in ways which will help them prepare for what are currently considered to be primary school grades.
