SPORTS ACTIVITIES -- MIDDLE SCHOOL

The physical education program in the middle school shall include a wide variety of selected, educationally appropriate activities designed to meet the needs of students at this level. The after-school program shall be an outgrowth of the physical education class instructional program and shall include intramurals and athletics for all students. All phases of the physical education program shall be organized and conducted in keeping with sound, current, educational principles.

There shall be no tackle football in middle school, grades 6-8.

There shall be no boxing in middle schools.

The guide prepared by the Physical Education Department, Division of Life Skills, of Miami-Dade County Public Schools concerning sports activities at the middle school level states that all participants must be presently registered in the middle school which they are representing.
