INSTRUCTIONAL AIDS FEES

The Board will make every effort to provide all instructional equipment, books, and materials needed to maintain the desired instructional program so that students, parents, PTA/PTSA's, or school fund-raising activities are not needed to provide these items.

Funds for such equipment, books, and materials are to be allocated to the schools on an equitable (not necessarily equal) basis.

All equipment, books and materials should be determined by the nature of the instructional program offered rather than having the instructional program determined by equipment, books, and materials.

Distribution of free and inexpensive materials in school (especially those free materials supplied by special interest groups) should be condoned only if such items are related directly to the instructional program. These items may contain some sort of credit line, but should be free of advertising or wording which may detract from their effectiveness as instructional aids.
