Instruction--Elementary and Secondary

EVALUATION OF THE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

The Board expects its faculty and administration to evaluate regularly the education program. Such evaluation may be expected to lead to recommendations for modifications of practice, changes in content, and new courses.

After planning by the faculty and approval by the administration, new courses will be presented to the Board for approval.

Normally, new courses will be introduced on an experimental basis and will be evaluated at least annually by the school and District office staffs. A report of the evaluation is to be submitted to the Board.

When the Superintendent of Schools considers that an experimental course should become a regular part of the curriculum, such a recommendation will be presented to the Board for adoption.
