PROGRAM EVALUATION

A system of evaluating educational programs shall be established and maintained to accomplish the following three major purposes:

1. Provide the information about program effectiveness and cost that is necessary for determining how effectively resources are being employed to accomplish specific educational purposes.
2. Provide administrators, teachers, counselors, and other appropriate personnel with information that will enable them to modify, eliminate, or add programs on the basis of program effectiveness in serving student needs, and that will help them to counsel individual students and parents more effectively.
3. Provide an annual assessment for dissemination to the public which shall include achievement data in the basic skills areas of reading and mathematics for each school in the system, a socio-economic profile of the area served by the school, and other information necessary for interpretation of the data presented.
