The School Board believes that music, art, and physical education are fundamental subjects in the school's curriculum because they contribute to the rhythmic and esthetic development of the student's body and sensitivities.

To give practical expression to that belief, the School Board authorizes the establishment of sufficient full-time positions for music and art instruction and full-time positions for physical education to be readily available to each school.
