

**School Board--Methods of Operation****METHODS OF OPERATION**

The Dade County School Board exercises legislative authority over the schools in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. It determines policy, delegates executive, supervisory and instructional authority to its employees, and appraises the results achieved in light of the goals of the school system.

The Board shall concern itself primarily with broad questions of policy and with the appraisal of results, rather than with administrative details. The application of policies is an administrative task to be performed by the Superintendent of Schools and his/her staff, who shall be held responsible for the effective administration and supervision of the entire school system.
