School Board--Methods of Operation

COMMITTEES--TEMPORARY

The chair of the Board may from time to time, after consultation with Board members, appoint committees composed of Board members, or of nonmembers such as school administrators, professional specialists, or citizens of specialized competency to explore subjects or areas requiring investigative development. Board members appointed to such committees may act as voting members and may hold office on such committees.

The Superintendent of Schools also may appoint professional or lay committees or a combination of both to study, investigate, research, or to develop procedures, courses, methods, or means for improving the school system. In making appointments of persons to lay committees, the Superintendent of Schools is urged to confer with Board members. Board members may serve on such committees in a voting capacity and may hold office on such committees.

The duties of the committees will be outlined at the time of appointment. A committee will be considered dissolved when its final report has been received by the Board.
