School Board--Methods of Operation

BOARD RULES

The Board, representing the people of Dade County, is the legislative body which determines all questions of general policy to be employed in the conduct of the public schools, as long as such policy decisions are in harmony with the laws of the State of Florida, the Rules of the State Department of Education, and decisions of the courts.

Proposals regarding rules may originate at any of several sources such as: a parent, a taxpayer, a professional employee, a member of the Board, a clerk, the Superintendent of Schools, a professional consultant, a teacher, a civic group and others.

Proposals for new or revisions to existing rules shall be submitted in writing to the Superintendent of Schools.

Action on such proposals, whatever their source, is taken finally by the Board in accordance with Board Rule 6Gx13- 8C-1.06.
